

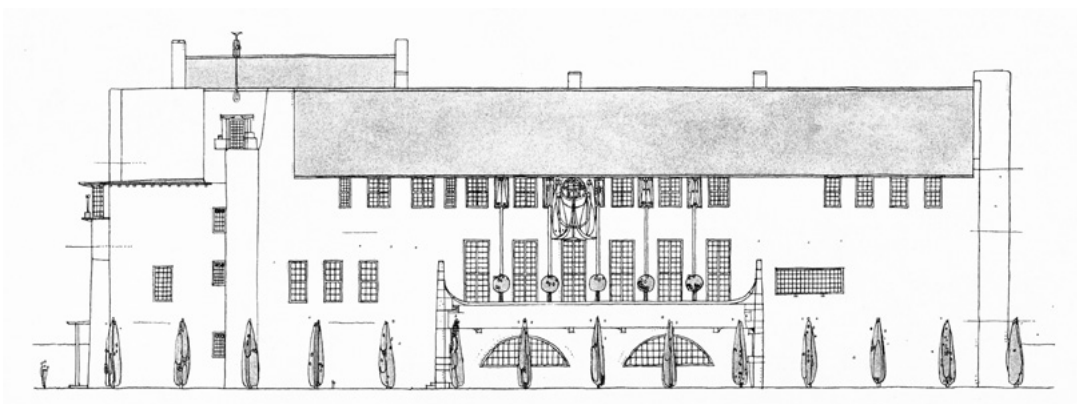


HOUSE FOR AN ART LOVER

Although the House was not realised through Mackintosh's lifetime, his vision of a grand house where one can be entertained, became reality in 1996 when the House was completed.

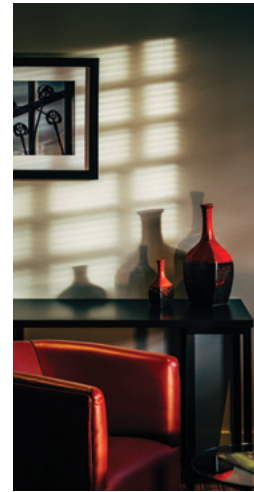

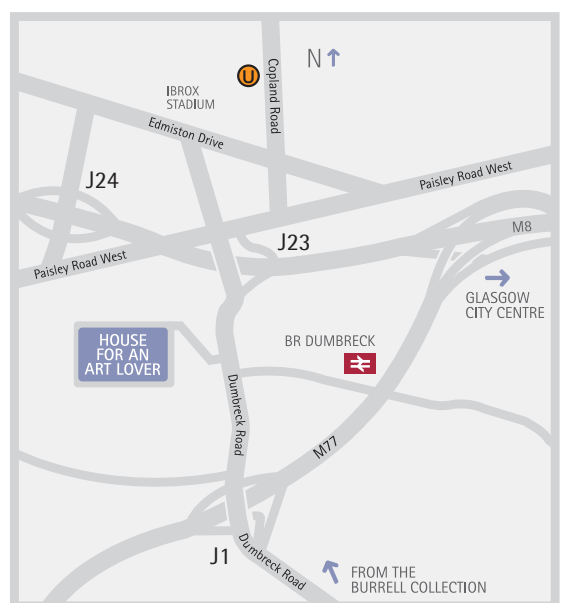
## Directions to House for an Art Lover
